



## Parking Information 2017-2018 School Year

Wingra School's building houses our school as well as New Morning Nursery School. We also provide space for Dudgeon-Monroe Neighborhood Association meetings as well as City of Madison elections. Given the amount of people coming and going each day, finding adequate parking is often difficult. For the safety and well being of all, parents are asked to review and sign the following policy statement:

- Those who drive to school are encouraged to car-pool. The school directory, available early in the year, lists the addresses and phone numbers of families to help in arranging car-pools.
- Follow parking regulations and laws, including being respectful of neighbors' driveways and avoiding the "no parking" zone heading up the hill near the Western Avenue door. The police will issue tickets to cars parked there.
- Other than those authorized to use the handicapped space, **parents may never park in the parking lot.** This policy applies to all parents of children that attend both Wingra School and New Morning, Monday through Friday, in all weather, and even if children are not visibly present.
- Parents are responsible for informing all friends or relatives who transport their children of these rules.

## Transportation Reimbursement 2017-2018 School Year

Please keep in mind that students who qualify for transportation in the Madison School District area must meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. **Reside within the boundaries for the Madison School District.**
2. **Reside within the boundaries of the school attendance area.**
3. **Be five years old by September 1, 2017**
4. **Be in fifth grade or younger.**
5. **Reside more than 1.5 miles from Wingra School.**

If you reside within the boundaries of other school districts like Middleton, Monona, Oregon or Verona/Fitchburg the requirements for transportation reimbursement are similar to Madison, with the exception that they reimburse parents of children that are in Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
