Extended Day will be offering the fourth round of clubs for this school year **beginning February 27.**

- Clubs may be open to all students or specific levels.
- All clubs Tue–Fri run from 3:15–4:30 pm and are \$10/session. Mondays: 2:00–4:30; \$20/ session.

Monday Science Club

Mondays in Extended Day are science-based. We take bi-weekly field trips (on odd numbered dates) to Wisconsin Institutes for Discovery (WID) for hands-on science activities led by UW students and scientists. When at school, we complete science activities based on our units of study. February's unit is Under the Sea, March's unit is Electricity. Students meet in Room 205 for activities or take the city bus to WID. On odd dates we will meet in the PEAC. Open to all levels. Six weeks. Tuesday German Club

Want to learn some German? Join Guest Teacher and German tutor, Chris Tabisz to pick up some conversational German and learn about the culture through games, songs and drawing.
